
For your information I am enclosing a copy of a letter I have sent to Dr J Nesbitt, the Medical Director at Altnagelvin Hospital. I announced at the Inquest that I would be writing to him and you about views purportedly expressed by Dr Murray Quinn who carried out an independent review into the death of Lucy at the request of Sperrin Lakeland Trust.

It would seem that his views differ significantly from those expressed by three experts who gave evidence at the Inquest as well as Dr Auterson Consultant Anaesthetist at the Erne Hospital. My concern is that Dr Quinn may hold views as to the appropriate fluid management for children which are at odds with "best practice." Accordingly, I am asking you to consider making inquiries with the Medical Director of Altnagelvin Hospital to obtain clarification of what views were contained in the report and the basis on which they were reached.
