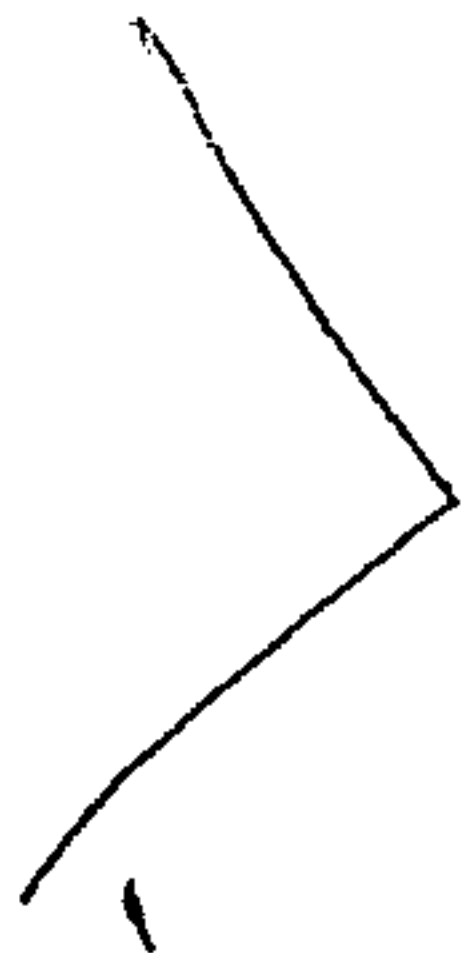

Thanks for the final draft of the hyponatraemia guidelines. They are factually correct and very concise yet comprehensive. I am a little disappointed that you have not come out with a "typical" or "suitable" fluid for children eg 0.45% NaCl but acknowledge that this would create its own headaches. I will continue to pursue a "hazard notice" for 0.18%NaCl/4%glucose through the CSM.
