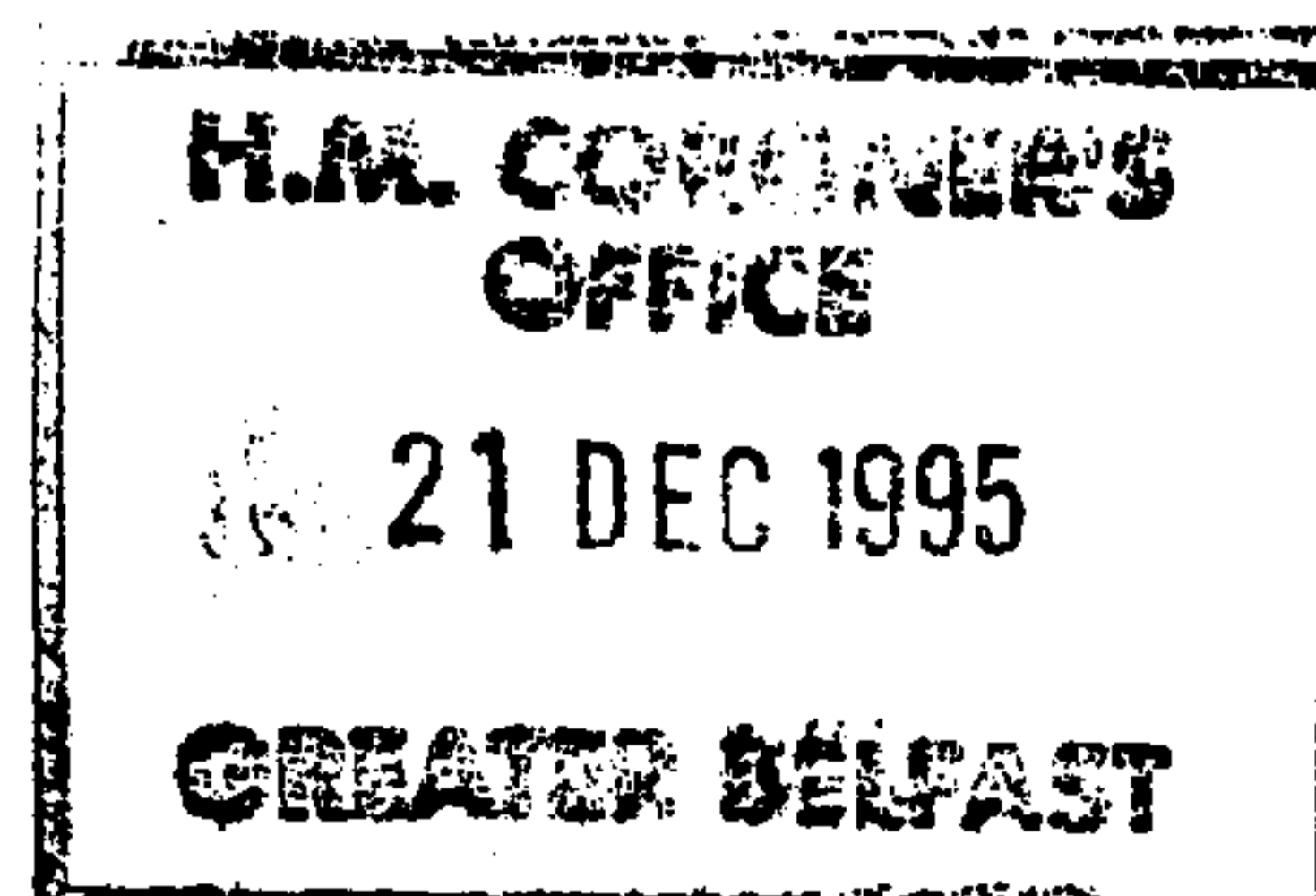
Dear Professor Crane,
