11. Findings:

On 7th June 2001 the deceased was admitted to Altnagelown Hospital complaining of sudden onset, acute abdominal pain. Appendicitis was diagnosed & she underwent an appendectomy the same day. Post-operatively initially, her post-operative recovery proceeded normally. However, the following day she vomited on a number of occasions & on the 9th complained of a headache.

The next day, 9th June, she suffered a series of tonic seizures necessitating her transfer to the Intensive Care Unit of the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children where she died the following day. A subsequent post-mortem examination established that she died from cerebral oedema caused by hyponatraemia. The hyponatraemia was caused by a combination of inadequate electrolyte replacement in the face of severe post-operative vomiting & water retention resulting from the inappropriate secretion of ADH (Antidiuretic Hormone).
