Adam was seen at the Dialysis Clinic this morning. As you know he has a peritoneal dialysis cannula in situ and will be admitted next Tuesday so that his mother can train in the use of the automatic peritoneal dialysis cycling machine. It may be that we can avoid putting him on dialysis for a little bit longer but because she has arranged to be off work next week I think it is important that we go ahead with the training schedule.

His line was checked today and is patent. He has recently had a urinary tract infection and is finishing a course of Ciproxin at the minute. We will arrange for an automatic cycler to be delivered to his home shortly and I have today arranged to have his tissue typing performed with a view to putting him on call for a renal transplant.
