Adam came to the Clinic today. He is obviously having considerable problems with breakthrough infections.

It is not clear to me why he should be getting this problem since he appears to have a urologically normal renal tract despite his cystic dysplastic kidneys. His renogram result, however, was not available to me today and since he seems to be in and out of hospital and I have been advising at a distance, I suggested to the nurse who was with him and his mother that perhaps we should admit him to Musgrave Ward so that I could get a better feel for what was going on.

therefore has been admitted under our care and I will assess his urological situation as well as his renal function over the next few days and let you know how we decide to proceed.
