
With reference to our conversation of yesterday 20th June 1996, I have marked any comments I think relevant on Dr Taylors report. I hope they will be of some help.

I would like to apologise again for the mistake I made regarding the reason behind Adam being prescribed Sodium Bicarbonate, but we do know now that Saline added to his feeds was to help control his Sodium (hopefully). Dr Savage would be able to verify that.

If Ms Higgins doesn't mind there are two questions I would prefer that she did not ask Dr Savage, the first one is when he would have preferred the transplant to take place, but as she has already covered this with Mr Keane, the Transplant Surgeon, I doubt she would want to go over this again. The second question is, when did Dr Savage realise there was little or no hope for Adam, he would have not been present when they tried to wake Adam up and I know that he is still upset by Adams' death.
