On the 8<sup>th</sup> May, I received a phone call from Joanna Mitchell to say that Conor had been admitted to Craigavon Hospital. I went to the hospital to give Joanna some support. I arrived at approximately 2pm and left shortly after to go and get Joanna and her mother some sandwiches and toiletries to freshen up.

I arrived back at the hospital at approximately 4pm. I stayed with Joanna so that her mother could go home to get a change of clothes for them both as Conor was to stay in hospital over night.

While I was there, I was very aware of Joanna's concerns about the seizures that Conor was having and we both noticed a rash appearing intermittently on his abdomen. On one of these occasions, I left the side room that Conor was in to go and try and get some help, and on several other occasions Joanna did the same.

I stayed with Joanna until Damien (joanna's partner) arrived which was approximately 6pm. While I was leaving the ward I met Joanna's mother coming back into the ward.
