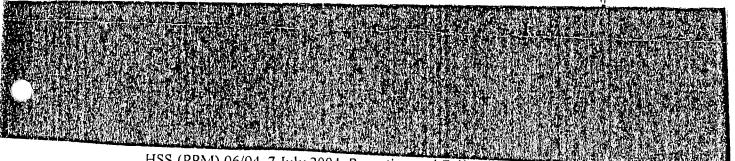
Welcome and Apologies

She then proceeded to welcome Sara O'Connor to the Committee as the Board's Governance and Risk Management Co-ordinator.

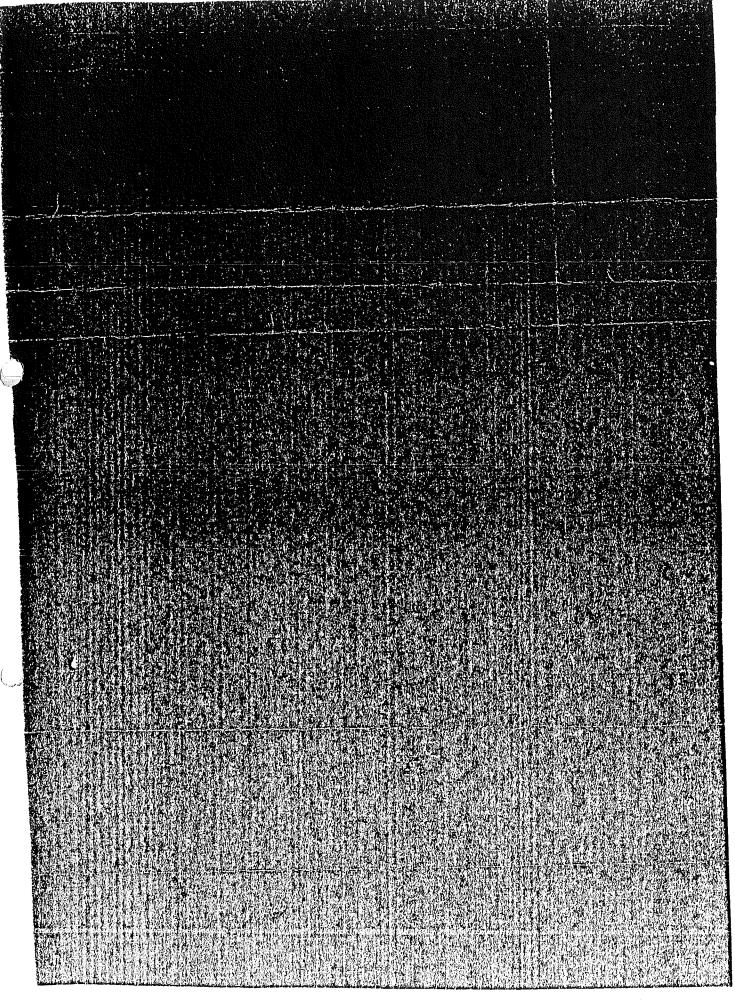

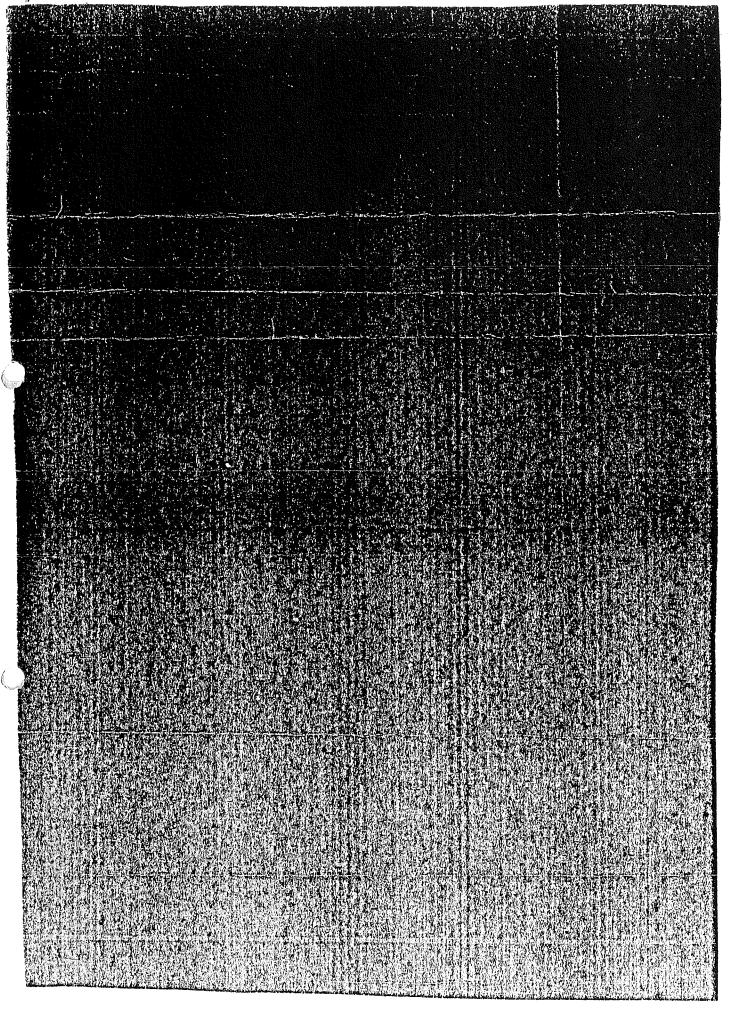

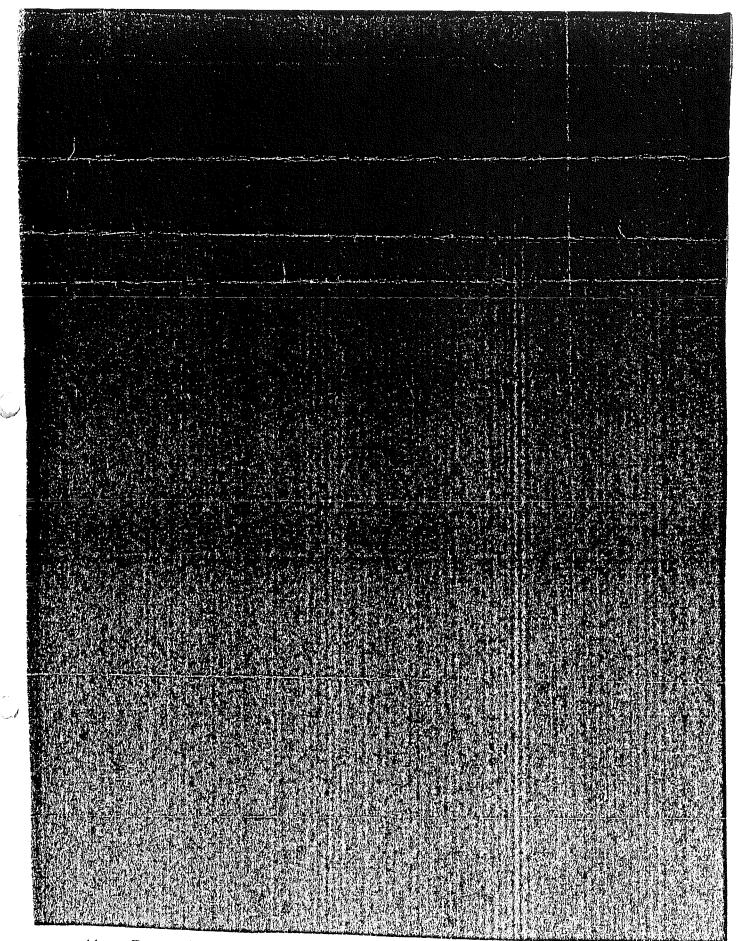


HSS (PPM) 06/04, 7 July 2004, Reporting and Follow-up on Serious Adver-Incidents: Interim Guidance

Sara noted that this is interim Guidance and that it is understood that final Guidance will be issued at the end of 2004/start 2005. She advised that she is working with the other Co-ordinators to produce a Policy for the reporting of serious adverse incidents by Trusts and Family Practitioners. In the meantime a letter has been sent to Trust Chief Executives requesting that, for the present, they report such incidents to the Board at the same time as they report incidents to the Department.
