Dr Woods introduced this paper.

Key points of the document included:-

- (1) lack of synchronicity with the planning cycle,
- (2) initiatives should follow a patient-led agenda,
- (3) workforce planning should be linked to Health Improvement Programme (HIP) and service needs,
- (4) consideration should be given to skill mix, rather than assessment on a uni-professional basis.

Members considered that while the document set the right direction, there was a need for emphasis on:-

- (1) recognition of the increasing workload involving primary care, rather than the focus being on hospital doctors,
- (2) a focus on Continuing Professional Development (CPD) and anticipated future developments on skill mix.
