Dr Carson advised that following the NIO Report - Compensation Payments for Clinical Negligence, the Department is considering the actions required to take to assure the quality of medical records within the HPSS.

Several Trusts have taken forward a number of quality assurances initiatives. It has been decided a strategic approach is required as there is no uniformity within Trusts. Clinical Accountability Service Planning and Education (CASPE) research has developed an Accreditation and Development Records Programme (ADR) and this has been awarded to some Trusts, other Trusts have adopted the Controls Assurance and Negligence Scheme for Trusts (CNST) standards in relation to their records.

13. DEVELOPING BETTER SERVICES

This is an ongoing project which encompasses the modernisation of services. There are a number of initiatives which cross Trusts boundaries. Service improvement plans, chronic disease management and primary care all require to be taken into consideration. The Regional Strategy for Health and Well Being is to take a long term view (20 years) when considering recommendations on the way forward.
