



An Inter-Departmental group has been set up to look at the implications of these proposals for Northern Ireland. Although the process is in the early stages some of the issues being considered are:


• training for all people who are going to verify death.

- all deaths would be referred to a Medical Examiner.
- resource Implications.
- registration of death would now occur after burial or cremation.
