## Remit:-

- to act as a standing sub-committee of CMAC;
- to invest its representatives with authority to participate in CMAC's deliberations;
- to advise on policy and planning matters for the hospital services including inter-speciality relationships and the balance between local and regional provision taking account of epidemiological trends and the need to establish priorities;
- to advise the Department, within principles and methods approved by
  CMAC on manpower regulation. The advice will relate to:
  - the action necessary to ensure that sufficient numbers of doctors of all grades will be available to enable Boards to develop and provide a comprehensive service;
  - the action necessary to ensure an equitable distribution of medical manpower;
  - the action necessary to ensure there is a balance between the number in training grades and the number of career posts likely to be available and, if possible, by speciality;

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- the levels of establishment, for different grades and specialities, for each Health and Social Services Board;
- special action to be taken with respect to identified problems;
- the action, if any, to be taken with respect to posts which become vacant where the emphasis of the work has significantly altered since the post was created.

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
