

## Summary of Event

Patient was on dual antiplatelet therapy. The time of the medication was changed from 0600 to 1000. The medicine kardex was amended instead of being re-written for the new time and the amended version was unclear (See below). The patient later died from complications of not receiving the correct treatment.



## **Learning Points**

Nursing and medical staff have been advised that they must ensure that any change in dose or administration time of a drug requires the prescription to be re-written.

If staff are unclear regarding administration instructions clarity should be sought from a senior member of the medical or nursing team.
