

The statutory reference that you are looking for is Schedule 3 to the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1991 as amended by the Health and Personal Social Services Act (Northern Ireland)

We do not really have a reason to assume that the Chairs of the Trusts will not initiate the necessary action to ensure that the documentation is secured and indexed. Therefore, on reflection it might be better if the letter used the word "requires" rather than being framed as a specified statutory direction. In the event that difficulties are raised, statutory direction could be considered at that stage.




I would welcome your urgent advice on each of these.
