I am aware of the unfortunate death of Lucy Crawford and I wish to express my sympathy to her family. I know her case raised a number of matters relating to clinical care, medical records management, and the reporting of untoward events that occur in hospitals. I am content that these matters are being pursued through the appropriate channels and that real improvements are being put in place.

If the Editor of the Impartial Reporter raises the matter of the perceived reluctance of Angela Smith to afford him an interview on this issue, the Secretary of State may wish to use the following Line to Take:
