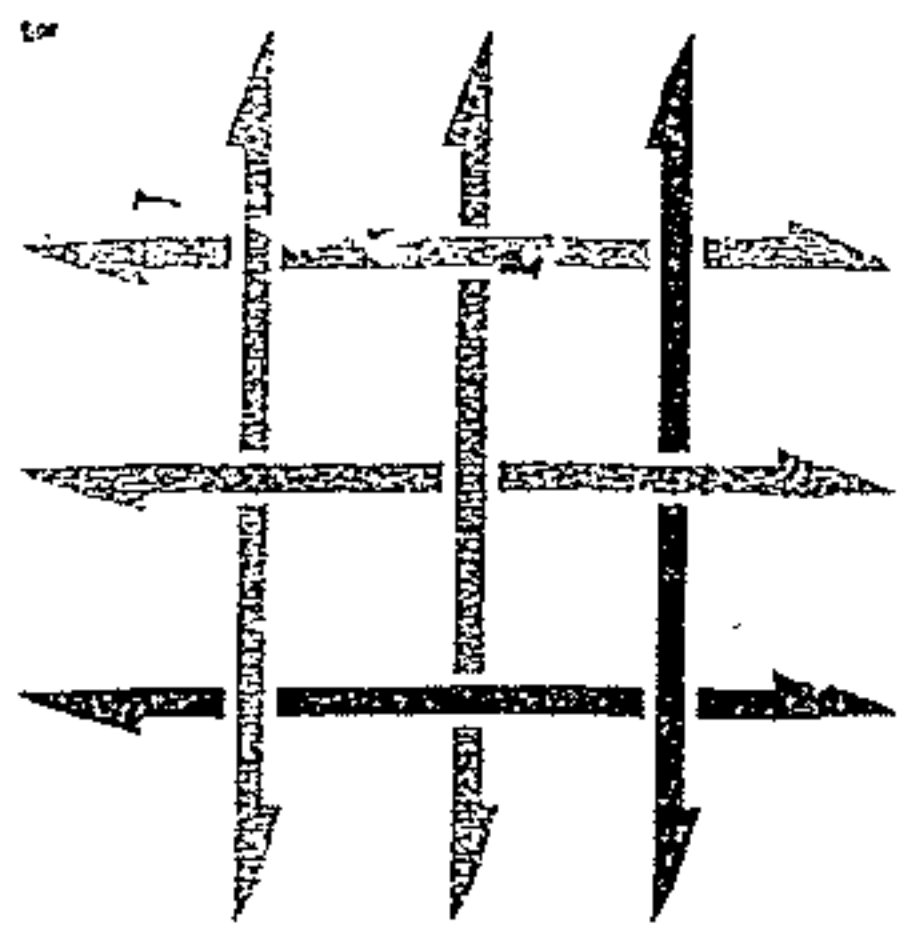




General Communication

fact that the media had been told that the RCA would focus on the LC case.

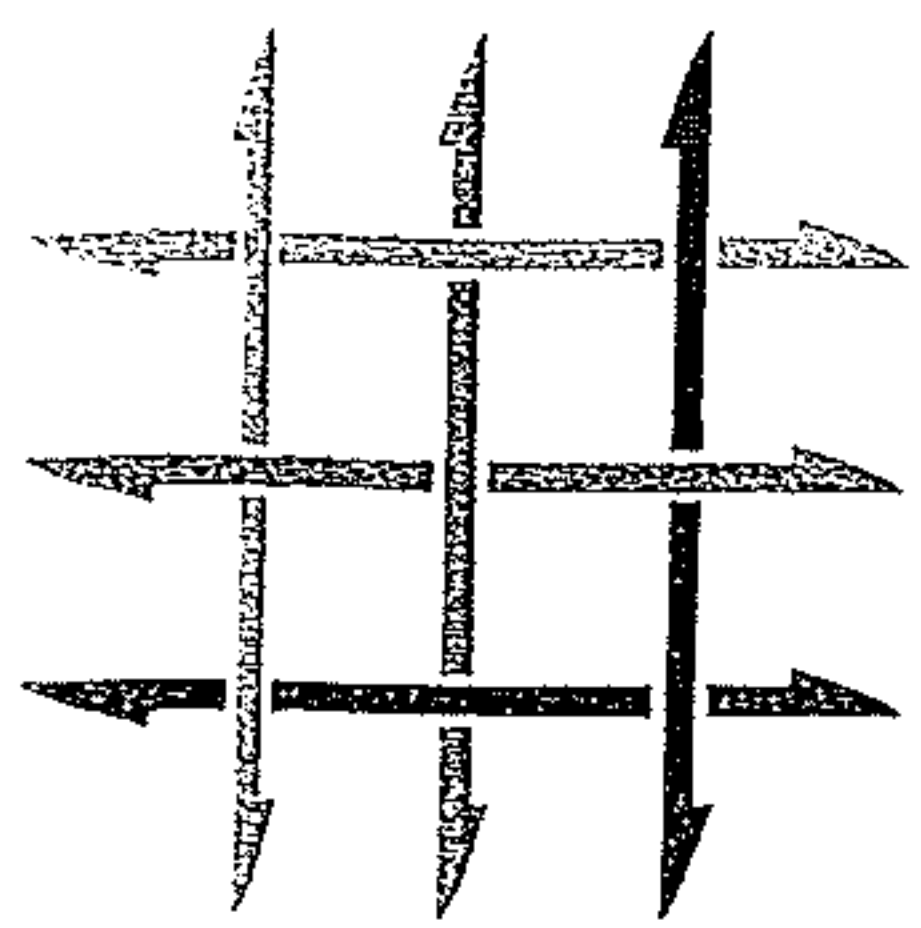
Jenny clarified that herself, Margaret and Diana
