Thank you for your offer suggesting the Minister will write to me personally. As I have explained, from my point of view this is not a satisfactory way forward. On Tuesday 5 April, at your suggestion, I sent a list of questions (seven in total). I received a statement from the Minister which, in my opinion and with all respect, did not address any of my questions. I hope you and the Minister will, therefore, understand my reluctance to go down that route again.

I recall I first telephoned you about this subject on Friday, 2 April, and in the five weeks since I have forwarded a total of seven requests for an interview.

Therefore, and in view of your latest reply, I believe it is pertinent to ask:
