We refer to our letter dated 12th January and your letter of 13th January, 2004. We note that it is proposed to hold the Inquest into Lucy's death on 17th February 2004.


We acknowledge receipt today of the proposed witness list. Please confirm that Dr. Evans will be added to the list.

In the interests of justice and to facilitate proper preparation for the Inquest we would ask you to disclose in advance thereof the following:

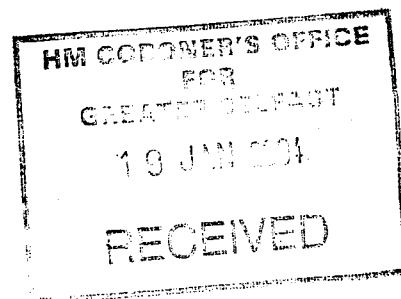
1. Any statements provided to you by any of the witnesses referred to in the witness list.
