Thank you for your letter of 20th January, 2004 enclosing copy depositions.

Our clients are concerned that Dr. Malik may not be available to attend the Inquest. We consider that the evidence and the attendance of Dr. Malik should be secured, if at all possible, given his central role in the events leading up to Lucy's death and the contents of the deposition of Dr. O'Donoghue in particular.

We note that the Erne Hospital have indicated that Dr. Malik's whereabouts are unknown. Have you been provided with details of the efforts made to locate him?

We suspect that efforts would have been made by the CSA to track him down in connection with the litigation. We also believe that the Trust would be able to obtain details of his whereabouts from the BMA or the Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety, if he remains employed in the United Kingdom.

Our clients can't help feeling that Dr. Malik's absence may hinder the investigation of the circumstances of Lucy's death but be convenient for the Sperrin Lakeland Health & Social Care Trust.
