However, I have another question for CMO in relation to our ongoing investigation:

In an interview for UTV's Insight on 17th February, 2003, following the inquest into the death of Raychel Ferguson, Dr. Henrietta Campbell stated:

"In the Health Service in Northern Ireland over the last 10 years, I am not aware of any case of hyponatraemia in a normal healthy child."

Question: Does it remain Dr. Campbell's view, that in February, 2003 she was not aware of the death of a normal, healthy child as a result of hyponatraemia?
