Reviewed letter from S/D McManus indicating that she was not involved in the administration of 100 units to Larry Crawford.

Spoke to Ste Traynor who commented that the fluid replacement volume was not unusual on a child of this age, given the condition. She also stated that there did not appear to be evidence of overload of fluids.

Reviewed notes again. She confirmed that the rate to be administered would normally be recorded on the fluid balance chart along with the type of fluids.

Spoke to S/D Swift who confirmed that she and Dr Hatch were present when the fluid regime was commenced by Dr O'Donoghue. ~~They were authorized~~ She states they were ordered to administer 100 ml per hour until they had produced urine. Nurse Swift was not involved in recording the 2.00pm or 3.00pm record on the fluid balance chart. Possibly Nurse Jones. Nurse Swift agreed to provide a report.

10pm Spoke to S/D McManus on telephone regarding the content of her letter. She confirmed that she had no direct involvement in administration or recording of fluids to Larry.
