


Dr. Kelly explained that the purpose of meeting was twofold:


- 1) to discuss the issues raised by the LC case
- 2) to discuss issues relating to the work of Dr. O'Donohoe

Dr. Kelly explained that informal notes would be kept of this meeting in view of the seriousness of the matters being discussed.

L.C. – Case

Dr. Kelly took Sr. Trainor through the LC case and outlined the report from Dr Murray Quinn – Consultant Paediatrician – Altnagelvin. Dr. Kelly explained the P.M. report. Sr. Trainor noted that Dr. Quinn felt it was unlikely that the fluid regime prescribed or the initial management of the child contributed to the death. Sr. Trainor did not feel that there was any significant time period when unobserved anoxic events may have occurred. Dr. Kelly outlined plans to meet with the family to discuss the Adverse Outcome Review. Dr. Kelly indicated that it was important to reassure staff as much as possible at this stage. Mr. Fee will be producing a formal report.





Sr. Trainor stated that she was aware of the two other cases:

The "low sodium case fell between a lot of stools and was not primarily a Dr. O'Donohoe issues – there were a lot of medical staff at fault in not identifying the low sodium early"
