Mr Hugh Mills, in an unprecedented step to address public concern, has given an interview to the editor (Mr Denzil McDaniel) of the Impartial Reporter.

Departing from Trust policy not to publicly discuss individual cases, Mr Mills agreed to go on record in relation to the death of Lucy Crawford in April 2000.

The Trust is expected to be 'hit hard' this week in the local media, but the view is that it was better to have done this than decline to go on record.
