I thank you for accepting Lucy for transfer. She presented at approximately 1930 with a history of fever, vomiting and diarrhoea. Capillary refill 12 sec. IV at approx. 1100 Initial investigation

Hb = 12.1 WBC = 15.0 Platelets = 397
Na⁺ = 137 K⁺ = 4.1 Cl⁻ = 105 (Or: 16)
urea = 9.9 Glucose = 4.5 Creatinine = 45

At approx. 0300 her mother noticed her very rigid. She was given diazepam 2.5mg. (but it is not likely much was absorbed). There were a number of episodes of diarrhoea - watery. a number of episodes of blood & mucus.

She responded (to pain) to crying and was irritable. Her pulse was palpable throughout.
