7.45 - Report.

Told by S/N McDowell of Lucy Crawford admission.

8.20 Approx: - Went to Treatment room Inside was S/n H Barnes Dr. Halik Ma + His Crawford. Lucy I introduced myself to the parents ... and S/n Barnes left. Dr. Halik found a small vein in Lucy's (L) foot and inserted a venflon No. obtained a blood sample and flushed the venflon with heparin at this time the needle was withdrawn it was then removed as it was not acceptable for IV fluid access.

I remained in the treatment room with Mrs Crawford and Lucy as Dr. Halik went to phone Dr. O'Donnell and asked him to come to the ward.

Lucy was given orange juice in a cup Approx 80. Lucy passed urine into a specimen bag and a sample was taken by myself which had protein and nitrites. The rest of the urine was placed into a white top container and was left ready to be sent to the Path. I dose Lucy temp. and it was still high so I gave her 1/2 Paracetamol 125 mg in the presence of her Mother. Dr. O'Donnell came to the ward - He suggested Elmex cream be applied to both Lucy hands which I did while we waited for the cream to work. I made up a drink of Dioralyte and give Lucy 100mls which she drank. She asked for li-

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Dr o' Donopue then visualized a conflict with Lucy's hand  
and flushed it with ~~the~~<sup>B</sup> water. I connected the i.v. line  
and I was instructed by Dr o' Donopue to run the  
jewels at 100ml per hr until Lucy had passed urine.  
In the presence of Dr o' Donopue Dr Halik myself  
had Crawford and Lucy. I connected the line to  
the deep venous line back Lucy and Mrs Crawford  
to cubital & median side. Lucy urinated + + bile  
colored urine, she remained sleepy but her temp  
stable. Mr Crawford and Lucy rested then came with  
the catheter. This was approx 10.45 AM and after  
this point I had no direct contact with Lucy.

After this time I attended to the other  
patients on the ward.

At approx 2.45 PM I was attending another patient  
with S/ju Mr Marion Sr Edmiston came with the ward  
and came to speak to us in the sick-room.  
Mr Mc Caffrey came over later as Lucy had a  
large bowel motion S/ju Mr Marion Sr Edmiston  
and Mr Mc Caffrey went to assist Lucy and her  
mother Lucy who then moved into a side-room  
approx 2.50 PM I was still in the sick-room  
when Mr Mc Caffrey called for help. S/ju Mr Marion,  
Sr Edmiston went to the other patients.

The patient I was with had settled so I came  
out to attend to the other patients.

I seen the emergency quickly and picked down  
the ward so I followed. As I reached the  
door of the sick-room Mrs Crawford asked me  
to phone her husband which I did.  
I left Mrs Crawford and her daughter with Mr  
Ward Sr Edmiston also entered the ward and  
attended the patients until

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Rucy's sister phoned and later her Grand parents  
came to the ward.

In the meantime I continued to attend the other  
patients.

Rucy's sister felt faint I took her to the day  
room I gave her a glass of water and  
sat her down by the window.

Her Grand parents were in attendance

At this faint I continued to attend the rest  
of the ward.
