8/12/91 1.30pm	Transferred from theatre and insertion of catheter. Pale and perfused from F&P W.E. Chest + Ray. Commenced on 5% saline running. 300mls drained from bladder. Bag changed. It Nappington tube draining well. It ureterostomy - blood at site. Effluent wounds. bag changed. Super pubic catheter draining well. Hip arthrotomy wound sutured and closed. Dressing changed. Pyrexia at 5.00pm. Paracetamol given. Vent rate 120bpm. Sealed drainage. Very irritable. Started on morphine infusion. 3A. Given 70mls Albumin as second day. It fluids calculated by previous 4 hours. Output + 10mls insensible loss. 4A. Pyrexia overnight. Given paracetamol with little effect. Urinary output good. Temp ↑ this am 38.4°C = tachycardia 105. Paracetamol given = good effect. Urinary fluid taken from bilateral ureterostomies and P.D.	Atterally
