Specimen: DUODENUM & OESOPHAGUS A & B.

CLINICAL SUMMARY:

G.O.R. Macroscopically normal mucosa. ? Oesophagitis, duodenitis. Both samples in same bottle.

PATHOLOGIST'S REPORT:

Two very small pale pieces of tissue were received. Both have been examined through multiple levels.

The duodenal biopsy contains superficial fragments of poorly orientated tissue. There is no evidence of villous atrophy or significant inflammation.

The oesophageal biopsy shows some basal zone hyperplasia but there are no other features to suggest reflux oesophagitis.

Both biopsies are rather small and may not be representative.
