This is just a note to remind you that Adam Strain's urological problems are unresolved. You will remember he was admitted for a retrograde pyelogram and this was unsuccessful. You had promised his mum that you would have his further investigations arranged by the time he came to the clinic today. I have heard nothing from you and neither has she. I would be grateful if you would contact her directly.

He is well today having finished a course of intravenous Cefotaxime followed by a short course of Ciproxin. He is now on Keflex at night. It seems inevitable that he will have further infections unless we get his plumbing sorted out.
