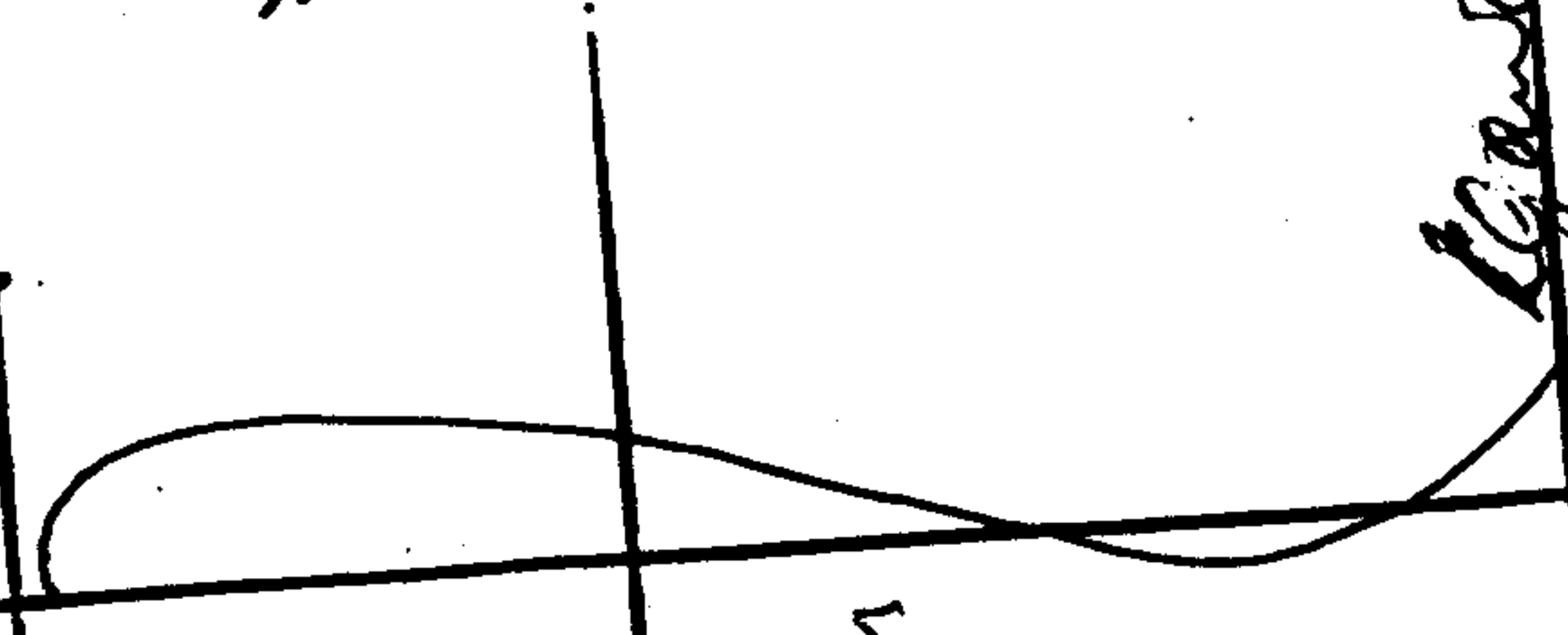

Potential risk of airway obstruction	To maintain clear airway	Nurse in semi-prone position or similar recovery position, according to type of surgery procedure. Nurse beside O ₂ & suction. Emergency equipment and drugs at hand.	Recovery position handled oxygen	
Potential risk of post-up shock	Early detection & swift action	To observe closely, maintaining & hourly T.P.R. Blood Pressure, colour sweating and drowsiness. Careful maintenance of body temperature with aids, e.g. blankets before admission and use of warm ganges. To observe administration of I.V. fluids as prescribed, checking site & hourly. Observation of any drains and catheter due to surgery.	Vital signs recorded for monitor	
Post-op pain	Control pain	Early detection of pain & discomfort before reaching peak. Administration of analgesia as prescribed.	Appears to be comfortable	
Potential risk of lack of communication	To provide complete report of patient in Theatre	To provide brief analysis of anaesthetic surgery recovery and pain relief procedures.	Reports to nursing ward staff
