Adam was seen today at the Renal Clinic. He has been keeping quite well since discharge from the hospital with no further problems with urinary tract infection. However he was admitted to Musgrave Ward on 24/11/92 with another urinary tract infection which tend to be pseudomonas. Therefore he was treated with a course of Ceftazidime after which he was quite well and was discharged from the hospital on the 4th December.

Also as you know he is having a problem with vomiting and sometimes he induces vomiting by himself by putting his fingers down the back of his throat. Therefore an OGD was done which showed ulceration of the lower oesophagus. Otherwise no abnormalities.

He was started on Cisapride and Cimetidine. He is to continue on his long term prophylactic Keflex as well as Sodium Bicarbonate. Mr. Brown will arrange for Adam to come in some time for retrograde pyelogram to see if there is anything that might be possible to do to help Adam in controlling his recurrent urinary tract infection.

We will see him again within a month.
