RE: ADAM STRAIN

DOB 4/8/91

Adam was seen at Dr. M. Savage's Nephrology Clinic on the 21st July. He appeared to be in good form although mum told me every other day he still has a low degree of pyrexia and this responds to Paracetamol and to sponging. No history of diarrhoea or vomiting. He is thriving extremely well. In fact he is definitely obese. He has a weight of 12.78 kilograms. He takes nearly 1200 to 1300mls of milk per day and does not take much in the form of spoon feeds. His last blood urea had gone slightly up from 8 to 13.9 and his creatinine was 243. His last haemoglobin was 9.6gms.

On examination I could not find any abnormality. I notice that he still has not had an eruption of his teeth. I have requested a FBP, U & E and urine culture and I will keep you informed if they are abnormal.

In the meantime he should be continued on his prophylactic Nitrofurantoin and Sodium Bicarbonate. Our plan is to stop oral iron after a period of three to four weeks.

We will see him in one month's time.

Adam was seen on 23rd June. He has been on Nitrofurantoin prophylactically at night. He still is polyuric and drinks about one and a half litres per day.

On examination he looked well. He had a mild inflammation of his throat. Urine culture has been sent. However it has come back sterile.

Our plan is to give him a course of oral Augmentin if the temperature persists. As he has already been on Fluconazol for more than three months our plan is to discontinue it now.

He will be seen in three weeks.
