Adam Strain is a patient of ours with reflux nephropathy and dysplastic kidneys. He now has a creatinine around 500 although his urea is well controlled at 10. He passes two litres a day but he is obviously getting to the point, at the age of 2.5 years, where he is eventually going to need dialysis.

I wonder if sometime before Easter you could put a CAPD cannula into his tummy. He already has a gastrostomy tube and has had multiple surgery because he has had five ureteric reimplants.
