I write in response to your letter dated 2nd May, and following the consultation with Drs. Taylor and Savage this morning (28th May). In the purposes of the discovery process I have had a copy made of the most recent and immediate episode of care from the date of admission for the transplant onwards. Within this copy I have flagged - for your information - the records of directly recorded blood pressure, CVP and heart rate taken in the operating theatre and subsequently in the Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU). Additionally your attention is drawn to Dr. Savage's note dated 27th November. When you have finished with this bundle please forward it to the Plaintiffs solicitors.

I will have further discussions with Dr. Taylor about the various potential problems that may arise at Inquest and, will probably ^{consult with} involve Dr. Gaston prior to these. about the
