## Re: Adam Strain (deceased)

The Coroner has spoken to me recently on several occasions about this very unfortunate clinical outcome and has now written requesting that I obtain for him "as soon as possible statements from the clinicians involved."

### Additionally he has:

- 1. Requested a detailed statement from the anaesthetic technical staff about the equipment used during the surgery and anaesthesia. This has been arranged.
- Referred the matter to the Health & Safety Inspectorate for a review of our anaesthetic systems. This will be facilitated through this office.

In order that you may prepare the requested report, I am sending with this letter an extract copy of the recent casenotes. I have to send the original of Volume 10 to Dr John Alexander, Consultant Anaesthetist who has been retained by the Coroner as an independent medical expert.
