With the sensitivity settings at 3uv/mm and the high frequency filter setting at 100Hz-no clearcut background frequencies were observed. Occasionally the patient moved and some sinusoidal slow waves were seen in generalised distributions. On one occasion no body movements were detected with this slow activity

Auditory and tactile stimulus evoked no response.

The patient's nurse moved the child-mimicing the body movement made by the child alone and the activity recorded was the same.

Diagnosis:

This EEG is effectively isoelectric and no discernible cerebral activity is apparent.
