Drowsiness and pyrexia for a few days. Seizures. Now unresponsive.

There is diffuse reduced attenuation noted bilaterally in both cerebral hemispheres. There is also reduced attenuation noted in the cerebellar hemisphere. I note that the differentiation between grey and white matter can still be seen in the supero-tentorial compartment.

There is marked encroachment on the basal cisterns, in particular there is total obliteration of the quadrigeminal plate cistern. Attenuation of the size of the fourth ventricle. Also both lateral and third ventricles are
