Questions for Sperrin Lakeland Trust

1. Why was Lucy Crawford's drip changed from Solution 18 to a normal saline drip during the attempt to resuscitate her?
2. What was the diagnosis of her condition at that stage?
3. Following Lucy's death, who at the Erne Hospital liased with the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children as the RBHSC formulated Lucy's medical history for the post mortem report? What information was provided for the clinical history?
4. When did the Sperrin Lakeland Trust receive the full mortem report?
5. Did the Sperrin Lakeland Trust make any authority outside of the Trust aware that it was conducting a review of the death of Lucy Crawford? If so, whom?

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
