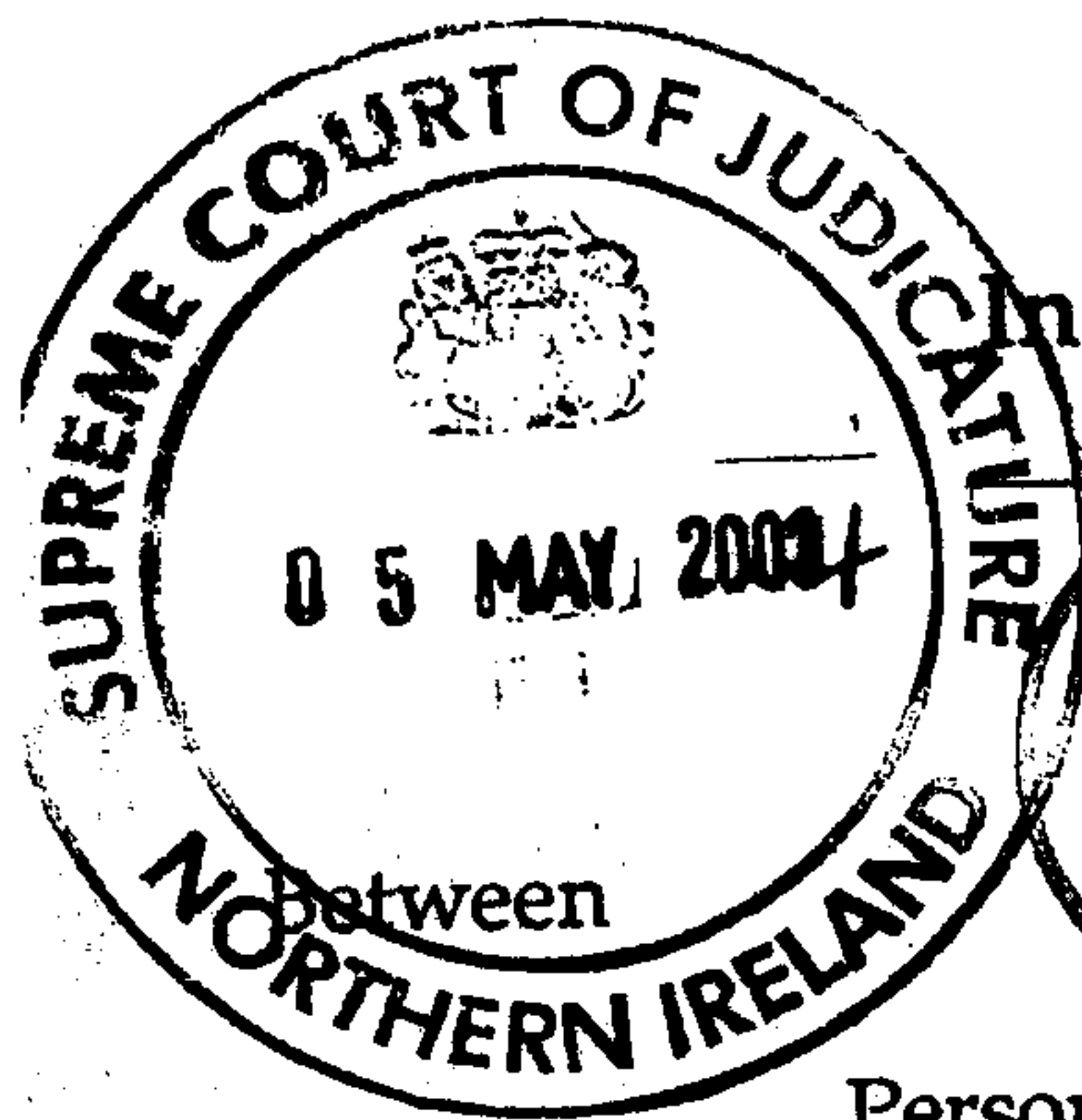

DIRECTIONS FOR ENTERING APPEARANCE

The defendant may enter an appearance in person or by a solicitor either (1) by handing in the appropriate forms, duly completed, at the
Central Office or Chancery Office (as appropriate), Royal Courts of Justice, Chichester Street, Belfast BT1 3JF, or (2) by sending them to that
office by post. The appropriate forms may be purchased at H.M. Stationery Office, Chichester Street, Belfast BT1 1PS.

The Plaintiff's claim is for damages including exemplary damages for personal injury, loss and damage sustained by reason of the negligence and breach of statutory duty of the Defendant, its servants and agents, in and about the treatment, care, advice and information relating to the Plaintiff's daughter Raychel Ferguson (deceased) on or about 10th day of June 2001 at the Altnagelvin Hospital and the Plaintiff's claim damages under the Fatal Accidents (Northern Ireland) Order 1977 as amended for bereavement, pain and suffering, reasonable funeral expenses, services dependency, loss and damage relating to the same cause.

If the Plaintiff sues, or the defendant is sued, in a respective capacity, this must be stated in the endorsement of claim.

AND the Plaintiffs claim interest thereon pursuant to statute.

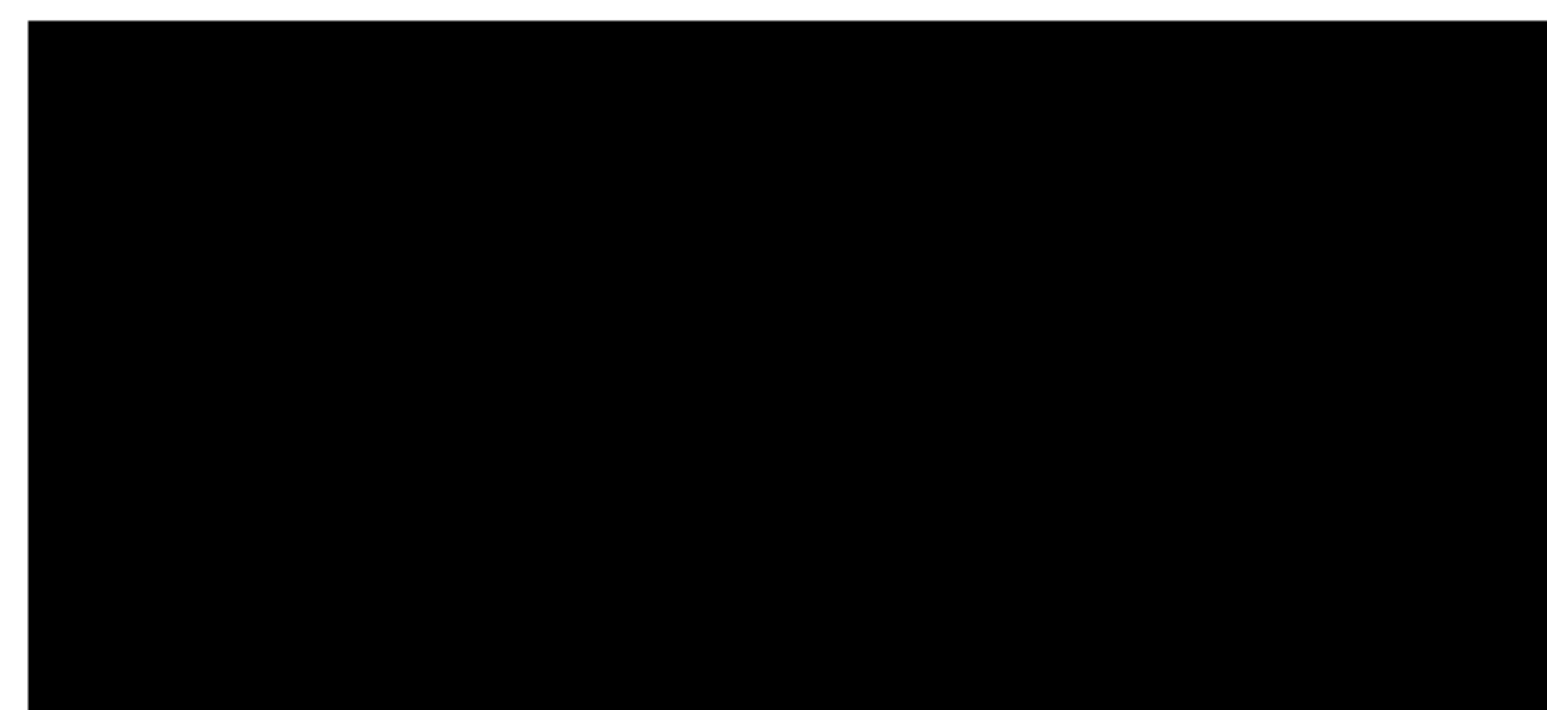
