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Planned UTV programme and their request for interview with Sperrin Lakeland Trust

At this stage, the Sperrin Lakeland Health and Social Care Trust feels it is constrained in participating in the above programme as there is ongoing litigation and the Trust, the CMO and GMC are examining the findings of the Coroners Inquest.
