

Thankyou for sending me a copy of Dr Armours' report which although I found upsetting, was helpful. Unfortunately there was one point which was not quite right (see attached). Adam was only fed 600mls during the day not 900mls, as stated by Dr Armour. From what I have been told a major factor which caused Adam to suffer Dilutional Hyponatraemia was Fluid Overloading.

I thought it best to inform you that he was fed 2100mls in total per day, which was less than he received in his five hours of surgery.

I hope this information will be of some use to you.
