Background

Lucy Crawford, a 17 month old child, was admitted to the Erne Hospital Enniskillen on 12 April 2000 with a history of vomiting and fever. It was believed she was suffering from gastroenteritis. Her condition did not improve and she collapsed at about 3.00am on 13 April. She was transferred by ambulance shortly after 6.00am to the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children. She died at 13.15 hours on 14 April. The inquest, completed on 19 February 2004, concluded that Lucy died from (a) Cerebral oedema, (b) acute dilutional hyponatraemia, (c) excess dilute fluid.
