Thank you for taking this baby. She was admitted on 28/7/87 with a history of twitching & eyes rolling for a period of 1-2 mins. Afterward fine (24 hrs previously)

On morning of admission further episode lasting several minutes.

O/E: NAD altho' somewhat snuffy CXR showed a little peribronchial peribronchial thickening.

I saw her on 4/8/87 & Mum described ~~no~~ further episodes where she shook & eyes rolled. Her developmental status was thought to be reasonable when awake.
