I previously made a statement to police on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2006 regarding this matter. Detective Constable Monaghan has asked me if I remember where I met and spoke with Staff Nurse Clinghan, it was in the corridor outside theatres. I have also been asked about who was present in the theatre when I went in. I can only say that I remember Patrick Keane (surgeon) being at the table. There was another surgeon, however, I do not recall who it was. There were other staff present in the operating theatre; however, I do not recall who they were. I remember when I was in the theatre wondering why they were continuing with the procedure if the child was supposed to be brain stem dead; however, I would not be able to say what part of the procedure they were at.
