Re: Death of Adam STRAIN

Thank you for your letter of 14th April.

I can confirm that I have extensive experience in paediatric renal pathology.

It is difficult to predict what might be said about the time of infarction without examining the material. I think it unlikely that one would be able to time with any precision, but I am willing to look at the sections and provide an independent opinion.

I would require all the paraffin-embedded tissue blocks (not the glass slides) from the transplanted kidney so that I could have my own sections and special stains applied. Once I receive the blocks, the technical work would take approximately one week and I could provide a written statement in another week.

4. I would also require copies of the other statements about infarction of the kidney so that I can understand the conflicting views expressed.

Let me know if I can be of help.
