Thankyou for sending me a copy of Dr Armours' report which although I found upsetting, was helpful. Unfortunately there was one point which was not quite right ( see attached). Adam was only fed 600mls during the day not 900mls, as stated by Dr Armour. From what I have been told a major factor which caused Adam to suffer Dilutional Hyponatraemia was Fluid Overloading.

I thought it best to inform you that he was fed 2100mls in total per day, which was less than he received in his five hours of surgery.

I hope this information will be of some use to you.
