I am conducting an investigation into the circumstances surrounding the death of a child in the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children (RBHSC) in November 1995. In the course of my enquiries it is important that I speak to Staff Nurse Mathewson as a witness. Staff Nurse Mathewson was employed at the RBHSC in November 2005 but I am informed she ended her employment there before 2000. While I believe I have given you the correct spelling of her name I cannot be certain (Mathison may also be possible). Since I cannot offer an identification number for her it may be that you will wish to contact any nurse identified by your check to ensure you are disclosing to me the details of the relevant person.

I therefore request, if it is possible for you, that you furnish me with relevant contact details for Staff Nurse Mathewson, in accordance with Section 29(1)(a) of the Data Protection Act which allows for such disclosure to prevent or detect crime.
