- 3. Please review the period from 0315-0630 on 9th. Can you advise on:
 - (i) was hyponahraemia identified sufficiently swiftly and addressed appropriately;
 - (ii) was every step taken to retrieve Raychel's situation?
 - (iii) was the gap between the two blood tests excessive and harmful.
- 4. Please expand on Points 2, 5, 6, 7 was the initial prescription correct? Should it have been changed, and if so, when?
- 5. Please advise on the roles of Doctors Curran and Devlin.
