RE RAYCHEL FERGUSON – AUTOPSY NUMBER NPPM 61/2001

Thank you for your telephone call on this date.

You are aware that police are investigating the circumstances of Raychel's death. We would like to interview you as a witness in the course of our investigation. The purpose of the interview would be to obtain from you in a statement the following:

1. Your qualifications and experience at the time of the autopsy.
2. Your role and responsibility with respect to Raychel.
3. Your findings as a result of the post-mortem – this probably will entail simply identifying your report to police who will exhibit it.
4. Any other information you possess in regard to Raychel's death which may not be included in the report.
5. Any comments you may have in respect of other possible causes of death. This arises since the appendix seems to have had little wrong with it.
6. Our evidence regarding the role of Doctor Al-Husaini in the post-mortem.

We would also like to discuss your PM report so that police are confident they understand in lay terms your findings.
