I saw Claire at the Medical Genetic Clinic, RBHSC on 03-04-95. She was born on 10-01-87 at The Ulster Hospital following a normal delivery at term weighing 8lb 3oz. On Day 2 it was noticed by the nurses that she was blue and rather mucousy. In July of that year, aged six months, she began to have fits. She has been seen by Dr Hicks and yourself. She is currently on Epilim but has had no fits for the past three years.

On examination she has no dysmorphic features. Chromosome analysis had been carried out and revealed a normal female chromosome constitution - 46,XX. A detailed family history did not reveal any other affected individual.

I do not feel there is a genetic basis to this little girl's delay in development and fits. I explained to the parent that the most likely explanation for her condition is probably a degree of anoxia
